How to Make this Wait Strip:

1. Cut out the blocks of 2 rows as one pieces like this



2. Fold the two rows in half with the blank squares on top.



3. Cut in between each blank square in the top row.



4. Cut off the blank white square at the end of the top row.





How and When to Use this Wait Strip:

Sometimes waiting isn't easy for our children and students, especially if they don't know how long they will need to wait for. This wait strip shows the student visually how long they will need to wait, this is a good tool if you need to work with another child or student, grab something or set something up before moving on to another activity, etc.

- 1. Decide how long you want the strip to be, could be all 5 squares or just 2 or 3.
- 2. Show your child or student how many they need to wait for before you start.
- 3. As you are doing something that you need to do you can point to the square they can put down, from the highest number down to 1.
- 4. Once they have put all of the squares down it is time for them to "go" to another activity on their schedule.
